































Properly securing the product will help avoid delays caused by damage during transport.

Below, we describe in 7 steps how to properly secure your shipment:

| 1 | Pack the product in a sturdy cardboard box. |   |   |
| 2 | Do not reuse the same packaging multiple times. |   |   |
| 3 | If the product will not be shipped in its original packaging, be sure to protect it, e.g. with bubble wrap. |   |   |
| 4 | Fill the empty spaces in the parcel to increase its strength. |   |   |
| 5 | Center the item in the packaging and do not overfill the parcel. |   |   |
| 6 | Seal the cardboard box along all edges; you can use the H-taping method. |   |   |
| 7 | Protect the parcel against moisture, e.g. with stretch film. |   |   |
